Submission of Art, Entry Form & Objectives/Aspirations Due - March 31st & April 1st, 2018
Featured Exhibit for High School Seniors - April 4th through April 18th, 2018
Reception for all participants - April 18th, 2018 at 4pm

RULES AND CONDITIONS:

1. All entries must be original and not copies from other art work of any kind.
2. Artwork must have been produced during the 2017/18 school year.
3. Each student will be limited to 1 artwork per category in any combination of 2/D or 3/D.
4. Entries may be in any medium except mobiles.
5. **ALL 2/D WORKS MUST BE INCORPORATED WITH HANGING WIRE.** The artwork needs to be able to hang securely from a hook for the duration of the exhibit (two weeks). Tape will not hold hanging wire on the back of a piece – please affix the wire in a more permanent fashion. Please use plastic or metal foamboard hangers or wire with a strong adhesive.
6. Matted size must not exceed 36" X 36".
7. Each entry of artwork must be accompanied by an entry form. For 2/D entries-attach label with student's name and school to lower right corner of mat on the back. 3-D entries-attach label to a 3 X 5 notecard on string fastened to entry. Also, write student's name and school on masking tape attached to bottom of all 3/D artworks.
8. All participants enter at their own risk. LAHAINA ARTS ASSOCIATION will not assume responsibility for loss of or damages to artwork.
9. 3/D artwork must be protected in packing material when submitted.
10. Artwork can be mailed if necessary. Please email us about shipping arrangements (Erin@lahaina-arts.org). Artist is responsible for return postage.
11. Entrants must include a brief Statement of Objectives and Aspirations as well as the name of the college or school where they hope to continue their studies. Teachers may write letters of recommendation.
12. **Deadline for Submission:** Artwork must be submitted at the following locations:
Saturday March 31st, 10am-2pm to the Old Jail Gallery in the Old Lahaina Courthouse
or Sunday April 1st, 10am-2pm to the Outlets of Maui, suite H4B
unless other arrangements are made in advance. Entrants and their families should make every effort to attend the Artists Reception at the Outlets of Maui on April 18th at 4pm.
13. **Deadline for Pickup:** Exhibited artwork can be taken home with you after the Reception on Saturday April 18th unless other arrangements are made in advance.
14. Lahaina Arts Association reserves the right to reproduce images of submitted artwork and participant artists in order to promote the scholarship program and LAA.
15. **Award Parameters:** All awards will be sent directly to the college Bursar's office. Scholarship winners will need to submit acceptance letters and identifying data to LAA in order to release scholarship monies. LAA expects that all scholarship recipients will pursue an art related education and career. Scholarship awards are only applicable during the 2018/2019 school year unless you defer due to military service, serious illness, or illness of a family member which requires your involvement in the care process, in which case you will be required to notify LAA and submit appropriate documentation.
